

Class Summary (Oct 22 Wednesday)

Wednesday October 22 Class Re-Cap:

- Watched GENKI Lesson 3- Dialogue I and II (page 32 in textbook): Making a date!
- Read the dialogue from page 32 out loud as a class to practice reading; good idea to keep practicing reading aloud!
- **Details for the recording assignment have been posted on Canvas!**
- **New:** learned more general and specific time words (days, months, yesterday, today, etc.) on page 127
 - Practiced listening comprehension when せんせい asked questions like: あしたは なんようびですか。 (What day is tomorrow?); tomorrow= あした; day= ようび
 - Reminder that general time words like **きのう (yesterday)**, **きょう (today)**, and **あした (tomorrow)** **do not** require the に particle when constructing sentences.
 - In class example: [time] じごろねます。 ([time] go to sleep)
 - In class example: [time] じごろかえります。 ([time] return to)
 - ごろ (about *time*)—this references an approximate time and therefore does not need the に particle.
 - Specific time words: clock times, days of the week, dates and months, specific years... these ones **do** require the に particle.
- **New:** Making question sentences using time words and verbs
 - Ex: あした なにを しますか。 (What are you doing tomorrow? Lit: Tomorrow, what do you do?)
- **New: Kanji introduction- numbers-** textbook page 304, 305
