

Class Summary (Oct 24 Friday)

Friday Oct. 24 Class Re-Cap:

- Practice days/months/year in Japanese format- page 127
 - Japanese date format: Year → Month → Day → Day of the week
 - Example: 2 0 2 5 ねん 1 0 がつ 2 4 にち きんようび
 - 2 0 2 5 ねん attaches to show the year.
 - 1 0 がつ means number(th) month; October= 10th month.
 - 2 4 にち means the 24th day.
 - きんようび means Friday.
- As a class, we studied kanji from textbook, pages 304-305
 - Note the special pronunciation of certain numbers:
 - Ex: よねんせい
 - Ex: よじ
- Know the kanji for time: 時 (じ)
- **New:** Practiced large numbers in kanji! Remember that Japanese number system groups numbers in **4** and not **3**. For example: 10, 000 is read as 1, 0000. Every time you hit 4 zeroes, you move up to a new unit.
 - 百= 100
 - 千= 1, 000 (or 1000)
 - 万= 10, 000 (or 1, 0000)
 - Example: 78,639,200
 - Ask: *How many ten thousands are there in this number?* 7863!
 - Break into 4-digit groups (from the right): 7,863万9,200; assign the 万 after the 7863rd ten thousands.
 - Break the groups down into their parts: the left side is 七千八百六十三 and the right side is 九千二百
 - Combine together: 七千八百六十三万九千二百
