Friday, September 19 Recap:

- Discussed how questions with a question mark (?) don't end with *なんですか* (what is it/this/that?), *どこですか* (where is it [location]?). *This is for casual writing/speaking* and does not entirely replace the usual Japanese question ending. It relies on the listener to fill in the implied "... what is it?".
- Went over homework from the previous day (Page 50- sections A, B, C)
- Group Work: Page 54: ask classmates questions and fill in the chart at the bottom of the page. It's encouraged to use hiragana to write the responses.
- Homework: Page 54: Section VI- continue to practice and **incorporate 2 new information-gathering questions**:
  - *おしごとは?* ([casual] what is your occupation?)
  - *ごしゅっしんは?* ([casual] where do you come from?)
- Homework: Page 299: Sections II and III, reading and writing practice.
