

Class Summary (Sep 24)

Wednesday September 24 Class Re-Cap:

- As a class, we practiced speaking the larger numbers on Page 67 in section A using section 1 as a guideline
 - Note: just like when telling time, some of the pronunciations of the numbers have voiceless vowels. See Page 23 for more details.
- Introduced a new information-seeking question: _____ はいくらですか ("As for _____, how much is it?"); Page 67
- Practiced reading and making a sentence using _____ はいくらですか with objects on Page 68
 - Example: かさははいくらですか (How much is this umbrella?)
- Group work: Page 68: Section C (requires another person; follow instructions from that page)
- Learned demonstrative words which describe objects in relationship to the speaker. See Page 58, 59: **これ** ("this one"; refers to an object close to the speaker, but not the listener), **それ** ("that one"; refers to something close to the listener, but not the speaker), **あれ** ("that (over there)"; refers to something **far from both** the speaker and the listener) for translations.
 - **Teacher**: これはなんですか。 ("What is this?"; note that the object is beside the speaker, so the word **これ** is used)
 - **Student**: それはかさです。 ("This is an umbrella."; note that the object is close from the listener, so the word **それ** is used)
 - **Example of use**: The teacher is holding an umbrella and asks the following question:
