

Class Summary (Sep 26)

- Watched Genki video: "How much is this?" -> いくらですか and showed the interaction between a shopkeeper and a customer.
- Covered これ (this (one near speaker)), それ (that (one near listener)), あれ (that (one over there away from listener and speaker)) using example objects in class. **Page 70-C.**
 - Ex: これは ペン です (this is a pen)
- Reviewed **Page 69-A and 79-A** exercise and saying the answers out loud, focusing on large numbers (Page 67).
- As a class, we used the form: あれ は なんですか ("What is that over there?") from **Page 70-B** to name the buildings that are far away. See vocabulary list for Lesson 2 on Page 58-59 for building names.
- **New:** Demonstrative + noun ("this/that + [noun]")- *these must always be in front of a noun.*
 - この "this ... (before a noun, near the speaker)"
 - Ex: このペン (this pen...)
 - その "that ... (before a noun, near the listener)"
 - あの "that ... (before a noun, away from both)"
- Group work: Practiced この, その, あの with a partner- **Page 70/71- Sec III-A** using the example sentence: この/その/あの [item] は [price] えん です and answering questions 1-5.
- **New:** location word: どこ (where)
 - Ex: すみません。[location] は どこ ですか。 (Excuse me. Where is _____?)
- **New:** location demonstratives:
 - あそこ ("over there" (far from speaker and listener))
 - そこ ("there" (near the listener))
 - ここ ("here" (near speaker))
 - Ex: Two people are conversing, and one is pointing to a bank far away from speaker and listener (Page 72):
 - A: すみません。ぎんこう は どこ ですか。 ("Excuse me, where is the bank?")
 - B: あそこ です。 ("It's over there.")
 - A: ありがとう ございます。 ("Thank you very much.")
