

Class Summary (Sept 29 Monday)

Monday September 29 Class Re-Cap:

- Watched Genki video: ここ, そこ, あそこ, どこ in sentence format:
 - Ex: としょかんは **どこ** ですか。 ("where is the library?")
- Practiced saying where something is with different places; Page 72 (reviewed homework from previous class).
- Reviewed きょうしつ (classroom) vocabulary out loud; Page 81
- **New:** negative sentence- "it's not":
 - Ex: かさ じゃありません。 ("It is not an umbrella (かさ).")
 - **[noun] じゃありません ("It is not a/an [noun]")**
 - If you want to include a topic to frame the sentence 'what we are talking about':
 - *Extra phrase (polite, formal):* ____ ではありません。 ("____ is not/am not/are not")
- **New:** information-seeking question: "who" and "whose": **だれ (who), だれの (whose)**: (Page 73)
 - Other nouns in front of の:
 - わたしの とけい です。 ("It is my watch.")
 - せんせいの とけい です。 ("it is sensei's watch.")
 - Ex: これは **だれの** とけい ですか。 ("Whose watch is this?")
 - Ex: たけしさんの とけい です。 ("It is Takeshi's watch."); remember that の signals possession and is always in format [noun 1] + [noun 2].
- **Group work:** Page 73 Picture A, Page 79 Picture B- asking who this object belongs to using the above sentence これ / それ / あれ は だれの [noun] ですか。
- **Group work:** Page 71 Card A, Page 80 Card B- find out the price of each item using この / その / あのは いくら ですか。 ("How much is this/that?"). Reference large numbers on Page 67.
